Subj: ATTACHMENTS TO ELECTRICAL DISTRIBUTION STRUCTURES AND  
POLES AT MARINE CORPS AIR STATION AND LAUREL BAY  
HOUSING AREA

1. Purpose. To give information for attaching devices to Government-owned electrical distribution poles/structures (and similar poles/structures) at Marine Corps Air Station and Laurel Bay housing area.

2. Cancellation. ASO 11120.1B

3. Discussion. Electrical distribution structures and poles are for supporting the electrical distribution system and communications cables. These installations have been constructed to ensure compliance with the National Electrical Code and other standards. Unauthorized attachments to the poles, including field telephone wires and signs have been noted. Some of the attachments violate various codes, are unsafe, and jeopardize the integrity of the utility system and obstruct tall vehicles. There will be no attachments to the subject poles without written approval of the Public Works Officer.

4. Action. To attach a device to a Government-owned pole, follow these steps:

- a. Submit a written request to the Public Works Officer.
- b. State the purpose of the attachment, who will be making attachments, and their qualifications.
- c. Provide a sketch showing structure to be attached. Include pole number(s).

d. Describe devices that will be attached.

e. State who will maintain the attachments, giving a name and telephone number.

f. Give date when attachment will be removed and give Public Works a 24-hours' notice prior to the date attachment is to be removed.

5. Concurrence. The Commanding Officer of Marine Aircraft Group 31 concurs with this Order as it pertains to the Fleet Marine Force units stationed aboard Marine Corps Air Station Beaufort.
