1. Situation. MCAS Beaufort conducts enduring airfield operations to support the training, deployment, and redeployment of homebased Fleet Marine Force Air Combat Element commands as well as Fleet Replacement Squadron training.

2. Cancellation. ASO P3710.2T.

3. Mission. The S-3/5/7 Department, Air Operations Division, shall conduct Category 2 airfield operations support to aircraft from United States Marine Corps (USMC), Department of Defense (DoD), and allied commands.

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent. MCAS Beaufort will provide the operating environment for the on-going high tempo flight operations within the assigned area of operations in support of USMC, DOD and allied commands.

b. Concept of Operations. MCAS Beaufort and associated airspace and activities will be operated within published airfield hours. Provide continuous Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting and other essential support in order to set the conditions for the enduring success of tenant Marine aviation commands. All Commanding Officers, aircrews and personnel operating aboard MCAS Beaufort shall comply with the provisions of this order.

c. Coordinating Instructions. In accordance with the references, this Order is comprised of administrative modifications and substantive amendments, including:

(1) Airfield Operations Area (AOA) term referring to the area within the Level II Restricted Area (para 1.2.5.).

(2) Description of the Vertical Landing Pads (para 1.4.2.).

(3) Description of the LHD Training Facility (para 1.4.3.).

(4) Airfield Safety Zones defined (para 1.4.7.).

(5) F-35B high speed low thrust engine run areas (para 1.5.8.).

(6) New Thunderstorm Warning (T1) requirements (para 1.11.3.2.).

(7) Airfield Hazard Notification System (AHNS) (para 1.12.).

(8) Updated Airfield Diagram (Figure 1-1).

(9) Visual Blind Spots updated with new ramp (para 3.3.2.).

(10) Short Takeoff Vertical Landing (STOVL) restriction to concrete surfaces only (para 3.4.2.).

(11) Runway (RWY) 14 Procedures (para 3.4.4.).

(12) F-35 Practice Precautionary Flame Out Procedures (para 3.4.6.).

5. Administration and Logistics. Recommendations concerning the contents of the AOM should be forwarded to the MCAS Beaufort Airfield Manager via the chain of command.

b. Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI)

(1) Unless specifically marked as classified (e.g. Confidential, Secret, and Top Secret) the following are categories are subsets of Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) and are to be protected in accordance with 32 CFR Part 2002: Agriculture, Critical Infrastructure, Emergency Management, Export Control, Financial, Geodetic Product Information, Immigration, Information Systems Vulnerability Information, Intelligence International Agreements, Law Enforcement, Legal, Natural and Cultural Resources, NATO Controlled, Nuclear, Patent, Privacy, Procurement and Acquisition, Proprietary Business Information, SAFETY Act Information, Statistical and Tax.

(2) All individuals handling this information are required to protect it from unauthorized disclosure. Handling, storage, reproduction, and disposition of the attached document(s) must be in accordance with 32 CFR Part 2002 and applicable agency policy.

(3) Access to and dissemination of Controlled Unclassified Information shall be allowed as necessary and permissible to any individual(s), organization(s), or grouping(s) of users, provided such access or dissemination is consistent with or in furtherance of a Lawful Government Purpose and in a manner consistent with applicable law, regulations, and Government-wide policies.

c. Records Management. Records created as a result of this Plan shall be managed according to national archives and records administration (NARA) approved dispositions per (u) and (v) to ensure proper maintenance, use, accessibility and preservation, regardless of format or medium. Refer to references (x) for Marine Corps records management policy and procedures.

7. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Order is applicable to all personnel and aircraft operating aboard MCAS Beaufort, SC.
