Subj: TRAINING IN WOODED AREAS ABOARD MARINE CORPS AIR STATION BEAUFORT

Ref: (a) ASO 5090.10

1. Situation. Various units aboard Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Beaufort have unknowingly trespassed into off-limit areas to conduct training and small unit exercises. These areas are designated as hunting areas per reference (a), environmental sanctuaries, or other protected natural resource zones and are hereafter referred to as 'wooded areas'.

2. Purpose. To establish policy regarding events in wooded areas aboard MCAS Beaufort that are not assigned as Range Training Areas (RTAs).

3. Instructions. To conduct an event in wooded areas that does not require a RTA request through the Range Facility Management Support System, units must request approval by contacting the Installation Game Warden. Requests shall be submitted 72-hours prior and include the location, date, and time that the event will take place. The Installation Game Warden is the approving authority for activities that encroach upon wooded areas and no events are to take place without prior authorization.

4. Scope. This policy letter is applicable to MCAS Beaufort and all tenant commands. This policy is effective the date signed.
