





Subj: MARINE CORPS AIR STATION BEAUFORT PUBLIC HEALTH REVIEW

1. This letter is to inform you of a revision in the projected completion date of the Public Health Review (PHR) from spring 2017 to fall 2017. As you are aware, the PHR includes both an environmental and epidemiological study for Laurel Bay Military Housing, Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, and Marine Corps Air Station Beaufort.
2. The additional time will allow us to incorporate forthcoming vapor intrusion data and a more thorough review of relevant environmental documents and reports. It will also allow us to include an additional nine months of health record review data to the epidemiological study.
