The **EM-101** and its annual refresher **EM-201** were developed by the MCAS Beaufort Comprehensive Environmental Training and Education Program (CETEP) Coordinator IAW MCO 5090.2 and ASO 5090.8B to comply with applicable Federal and South Carolina State environmental laws and regulations and Marine Corps policy. The EM-101 is required for all personnel (military, civilian and contractors) working aboard this installation in areas where personnel generate/handle Hazardous, Non-RCRA Regulated, and Universal waste.

TRAINING REQUEST PROCEDURES:

- **Make sure that attendees are able to fill the billet for at least 1 year once appointed per MCO 5090.2 Vol 5 Ch 4.**
- Make sure that attendees have their **appointment letter** signed by their CO's prior to attending the EM-101.
- Attendees must have completed (3) MarineNet courses (**ECC Training "HQMCECCOM01", Intro to HM and HW "HQMCHMHW01", SPCC General Awareness "HQMCSPPCC1"**) prior to attending the EM-101.
- **OIC's, SNCO's or ECC's** need to submit requests via email to **Leo Lozano (CETEP) at carlos.lozano@usmc.mil**
- **Use TRAINING REQUEST for the subject line to ensure a confirmation receipt.**
- Fill out the Training Request form and attach to email.
- Call (843) 228-7884 to request a seat if you do not have email access.

Environmental Awareness

- Mandatory training for all personnel per MCO 5090.2.
- Training available onsite via the units/ work centers Environmental Compliance Coordinators.

Hazard Communication (GHS - HAZCOM) – 20 CFR 1910.1200

- Training available through the MCAS Beaufort Safety Office and CETEP Coordinator.

Hazardous Waste Operations Emergency Response (HAZWOPER) – 29 CFR 1910.120

- HAZWOPER Technician/Site Worker: Scheduled as needed via CETEP Coordinator.
- HAZWOPER Operations: Courses available via Marine Net (Contact CETEP for course listings).
- HAZWOPER Awareness: Covered in the ECC Course.

Hazardous Material/Hazardous Waste Handler Training - 40 CFR 265.16

- Training available onsite via unit ECC (Maintain training records for 3 years after employee departs, PCS, or EAS)

The CETEP Coordinator must ensure that the environmental training needs for MCAS Beaufort are met per MCO 5090.2.
