Subj: REMOVAL OF GASOLINE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS  
AT THE LAUREL BAY MINI-MART

Dear Laurel Bay Residents:

Recent remodeling of the Laurel Bay Mini-Mart included relocating the gas station to the front of the store to allow for easier access and less congestion around the pumps. As part of the remodeling, we are removing unneeded pumps, gasoline storage tanks, and fuel lines. There are no known problems with the equipment, and the removal is part of the modernization and upgrades.

Unlike home heating oil tanks, the Laurel Bay Mini-Mart underground gasoline storage tanks are regulated. Removal of the gasoline system and underground storage tanks will follow the process prescribed by the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control and all other applicable laws and regulations for regulated tanks.
